To Whom It May Concern:

The Office of Historic Preservation has received a request to remove 2151 Van Ness Avenue (formerly St. Brigid's Church) in San Francisco from Determined Eligible for the National Register of Historic Places (National Register) and from listing in the California Register of Historical Resources (California Register). The State Historical Resources Commission (Commission) is scheduled to consider and take action on these requests at its regular meeting on October 27, 2006, to be held in the First Floor Auditorium, Resources Building, 1416 Ninth Street, Sacramento, California 95814, beginning at 9:00 a.m. This room is accessible to people with disabilities.

At the hearing, the Commission shall hear comments and receive information regarding whether or not the criteria for determining the property ineligible for the National Register and the California Register have been met pursuant to Federal Rules and Regulations 36 CFR Part 60.15 and Title 14, California code of Regulations, Section 4856. Written comments should be sent to Milford Wayne Donaldson, FAIA, State Historic Preservation Officer, Office of Historic Preservation, Post Office Box 942896, Sacramento, California 94296-0001. So that the Commission will have adequate time to consider them, it is requested, but not required, that written comments be received by the Office of Historic Preservation fifteen (15) days before the Commission meeting. Interested parties are encouraged to attend the meeting and present oral testimony.
